On the palate it is dry with a creamy texture, intense flavours, excellent acidity, and a lengthy finish. It is an ideal alternative for rich courses normally calling for Chardonnay. On the palate, it has beautiful structure and acidity similar to Sauvignon Blanc along with enticing fruit flavours, and plenty of body for a wine that shows such delicate aromas and flavours. Fruity, floral and yet still quite dry, this wine has to be tasted to be believed. Best enjoyed in its youth either by itself, or as a wonderful partner with smoked meats, mild to medium- strong cheeses, Asian cuisines, and seafood, especially crab.
